Your Official Information Act request, reference: GOV-018048

Thank you for your email of 2 May 2022, asking for the following information under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act):

I am currently doing a paper on noise-induced hearing loss and was wondering if you could provide me with some up-to-date statics and any information you may have regarding this topic.

Your request is very broad, and we attempted to clarify with you on 5 May 2022. As no response was received, we have proceeded to make a decision based on our interpretation of your request, as outlined in the clarification email.

Noise induced hearing loss is defined where the claim has a diagnosis of *Industrial Deafness* or injury description of *Noise-induced hearing loss*.

ACC does not routinely disclose claim counts fewer than four

Accordingly, some of the values in the tables only indicate that the claim count is fewer than 4 (denoted as <4). In other instances, values are suppressed and denoted as two dots (..). This limits the potential for particular individuals, or matters specific to certain individuals, from being identified.

Withholding in this way is necessary to protect the privacy of these individuals. This decision has been made under section 9(2)(a) of the Act. In doing so, we have considered the public interest in making the information available and have determined that it does not outweigh the need to protect the privacy of these persons.

Ethnicity data
Up to six ethnicities can be chosen by a client when they complete the ACC injury claim form. Our system will prioritise the ethnicity data, as below:

Māori - regardless of other ethnicities listed, are classified as Māori.

Paclific Peoples = people with any other response other than Māori are classified as Paclific.

Asian - people with any response other than Māori and Paclific are classified as Asian.

Other Ethnicity - regardless of any responses other than Māori, Paclific are classified as Other.

European - people who do not list Māori, Paclific, Lain or Other are classified as European.

Residual Categories - includes those unknown or not stated.
